Scottish Nine Hole Opens

Conditions of entry and rules of competition

The competition shall be stroke play over 9 holes. Play will be from the White tees over the first 9 holes on the existing card for the course.

Open to amateur male and female golfers who are aged 16 or above on the day of the competition and who are members of a recognised Golf Club.

Maximum handicap permitted will be 28 (36 Ladies). Each entrant must be in possession of a CONGU handicap.

Handicap allowance for the competition will be half a competitor's playing handicap to one decimal place, e.g. a competitor with a playing handicap of 5 will play off 2.5.

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and in accordance with the local rules of Carrbridge Golf Club.

The competition will be non-counting for handicap purposes.

Entry Fees can be paid on the day or with submission of the entry form. Tee-times will be allocated on receipt of entry by telephone or entry form and a draw published on Carrbridge Golf Club's web site.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning any reason and to alter or add to these conditions. Its decision shall be final.

A maximum entry may be applied. If that is the case a waiting list will be maintained. The last tee-time will be 4pm or earlier depending on the level of entries.

In the event of a tie for the winners of the scratch or handicap section, the competition shall be decided on "count back" the best score for the last 9,6,3,2 or one hole (s). If no outright winner is obtained after "count back" joint winners will be declared and the prize fund shall be shared.

No competitor shall receive more than one prize, and will be awarded the highest potential prize voucher, depending on ties. Please note: Competitors can only win one SGU voucher and handicap certificates or CDH identity may be requested

It is requested that members and visitors observe Carrbridge Golf Club's dress code.

It is intended that the prize giving will take place on the evening of the event for those available.
